INTRODUCTION

Dashrath Prasad Ram Nandan Pandey B.Ed College, Chitragopi, Aurangabad (Bihar), run under the management of Satbahini Public Charitable Trust, Aurangabad, Bihar is the only educational institution aiming to train the secondary teachers (B.Ed) ensuring the quality of education by providing modern facilities and new techniques of teaching.

RECOGNITION AND AFFILIATION

The college is recognized by NCTE (ERC), Bhubaneswar (Statutory body of Govt. India), vide Ref. ERC/7-138.6.6/NCTE/ B.Ed./2012/ 13372 dated 18 August 2012 and Magadh University, Bodh Gaya (Bihar), for 100 intakes.

LOCATION

The college is situated at Chitragopi on the National Highway 98 (Aurangabad-Patna Road) 8 K.M. from Aurangabad Town and 3 K.M from Anugrah Narayan Road, Railway Station.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Any candidate securing 50% Marks in B.A, B.Sc., and B. Com Hon's Exam from any recognized university of India or equivalent degree from any foreign University can apply for an entrance test to be organized by the college. The date of examination shall be communicated to the Applicant.

FORMS AND PROSPECTUS

Forms and prospectus can be had from the college office on any working day between 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Payment of Rs.500/- (Five Hundred) only).

The form can also be downloaded on our website www.dprpbedcollege.co.in and also by sending DD of 550/- (Five Hundred Fifty Only) in favour of Dashrath Prasad Ram Nandan Pandey B.Ed. College payable at Aurangabad.

FEE STRUCTURE

- (I) Total Tuition fees of one academic Calendar course Rs. 55000/- (Fifty Five Thousand) will be paid by the student only through demand draft in favour of Dashrath Prasad Ram Nandan Pandey B.Ed College, payable at Aurangabad.
- (II) University Registration and Examination fee shall be paid by the student besides admission fee.

RESERVATION

Seats are reserved For SC/ST & OBC and other categories of students as per state govt. rules. In case the reserved seats are left vacant, it will be filled by the General Category Students on the basis of merit list of the entrance test. The SC, ST, and OBC candidates must produce caste certificates issued by component authority of Govt.

PROCEDURE OF SELECTION

Admission is based only upon the merit wise marks obtained in the written test conducted by the managing committee.

ENCLOSURES

At the time of admission the candidate will have to bring the following original documents with two Xerox copies and six recent colour photographs and the same will be self attested by the candidates.

5. Migration Certificate (for other university candidates)

IN THE CAMPUS

There will be a dress code for the students of B.Ed. faculty. All students have to come in the uniform. No students will be allowed to enter the classes, theories of practical, if he or she is not in the uniform. A Blazer, bearing the monogram of the college shall be provided in the winter. Laminated Identity card shall be provided to each student. All the students have to keep it with them all the time in the campus.

Behaviour of the students in the campus, breach of peace, discipline, use of any unparliamentarily words, misbehaviour with the fellow students, misbehavior with the teachers or any staff will be watched continuously. Students found guilty will be expelled from the college and he or she will forfeit the claim of the money deposited in the form of fees. Therefore, trainees should have to maintain the peace, discipline in the campus. There should not be any kind of ragging practice in the campus.

LIBRARY

One of the important components of a college is the library furnished with standard books on the topics to be taught. A well furnished Library has been established with about 3287 books on the different topics of Education. There are provisions for internet photostat and spaces and facilities for day study. Library cards shall be issued to the trainees so that they may borrow books from the library. However the trainees must refund the books after a fixed period for their better circulation among the students. The journals, daily newspapers etc. will be made available for study and reading in the college itself.

LABORATORY

Colleges has well developed different types of laboratories for Mathematics, Science, Biology, Arts and Crafts, ICT Psychology etc. which must provide good infrastructure as per the norms of NCTE.

SPORTS AND GAMES

Provision has been made for indoor and outdoor games Caroms, Chess, Table Tennis will be the items of indoor games while Badminton, Volleyball, Football, Kabaddi, Cricket etc. will be the items of the outdoor games Participation in the games will be considered a desirable extra activity.

SEMINARS, QUIZ & DEBATE, ETC.

All students will have to take part in the above activities. The faculty will organize seminars, debates and contests. Participation in them would also be evaluated

TEACHING PRACTICE & LESSONS

Ten pioneer schools situated in the area within 5 K.M. from the college have been selected where trainees will be provided opportunities of practice teaching. Trainees shall prepare a project report which will be duly certified by the principals of selected high schools/+2 level schools. The project will be evaluated at the time of practical examinations.

ATTENDANCE

At least 75% attendance is essential for every student failing which they will not be allowed to fill up university forms as per NCTE & university norms. Besides this, during the practice teaching, the candidates will have to prepare 20 (Twenty) lesson plans in each method paper and they have to take classes in the allotted schools.

THE ENTRANCE TEST

The duration of the test examination will be of 2 hours. There shall be two parts, part A and part B. part A will consist of 80 questions, each of one mark only while part B. Shall contain 20 marks, each of one mark only. The questions shall be of objective type with multiple choices. One question will have four options.

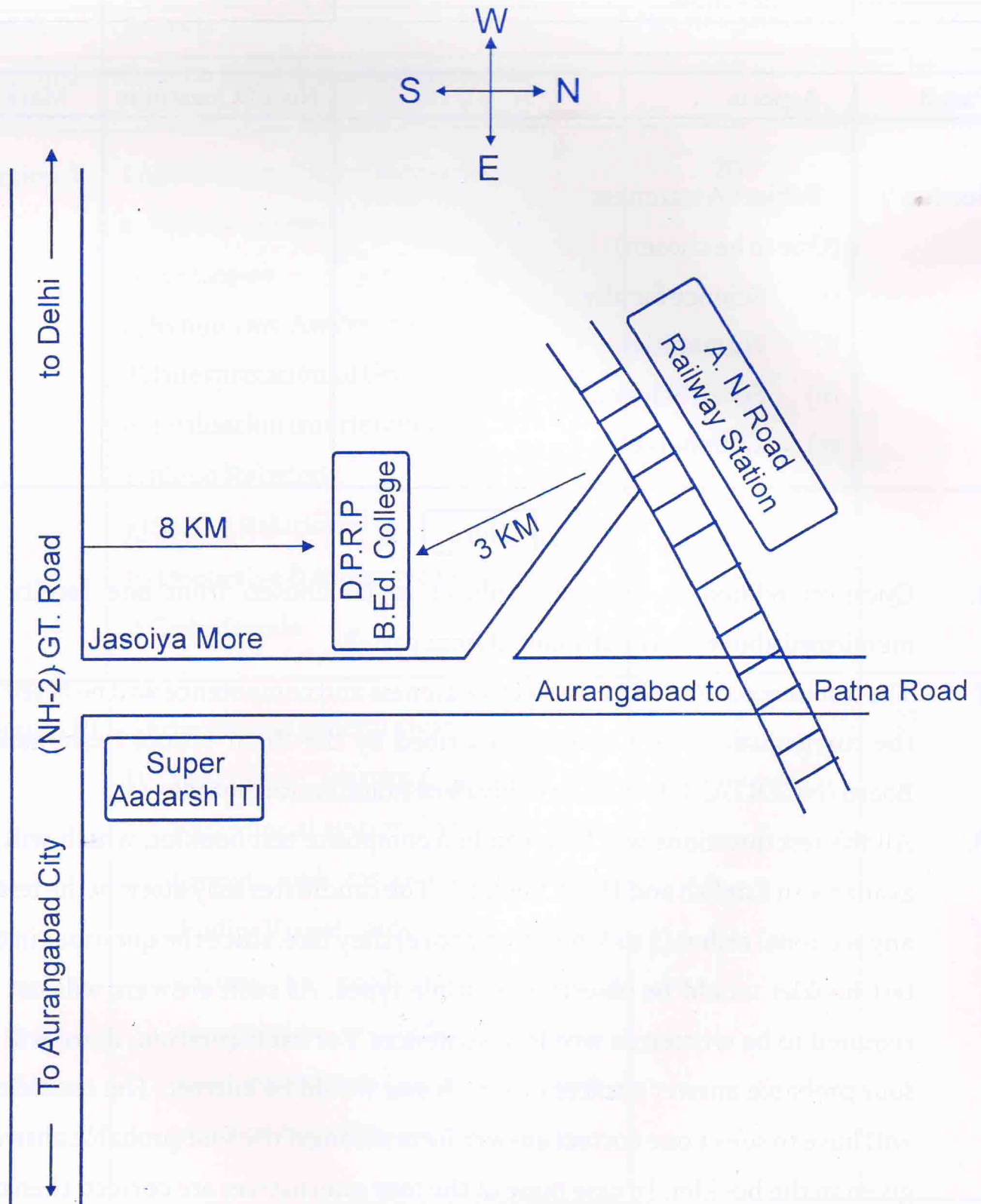

The candidates may attempt the test in any sectional order, (1 to V mention above) they like, since the questions in the test booklet would be objective multiple types. As such answers will not be required to be written in words or sentences. For each question, there will be four probable answer choices of which one would be correct. The candidates will have to select one correct answer from amongst the four probable answers given in the booklet. In case none of the four alternatives are correct, then the candidates will have to mark "0"

Road Map for DPRP B.Ed. College, Aurangabad

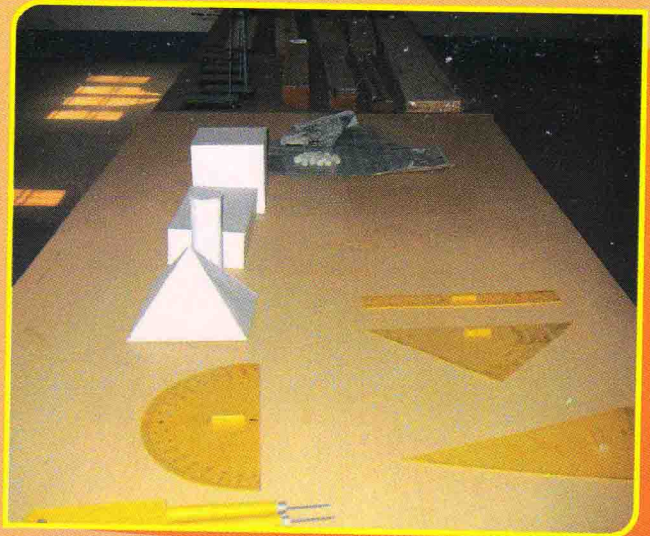
